Studio Mentors are available: an experienced printmaker from the PAWA committee can assist you with your printmaking in the PAWA studio.

\$25 a day or \$15 half day

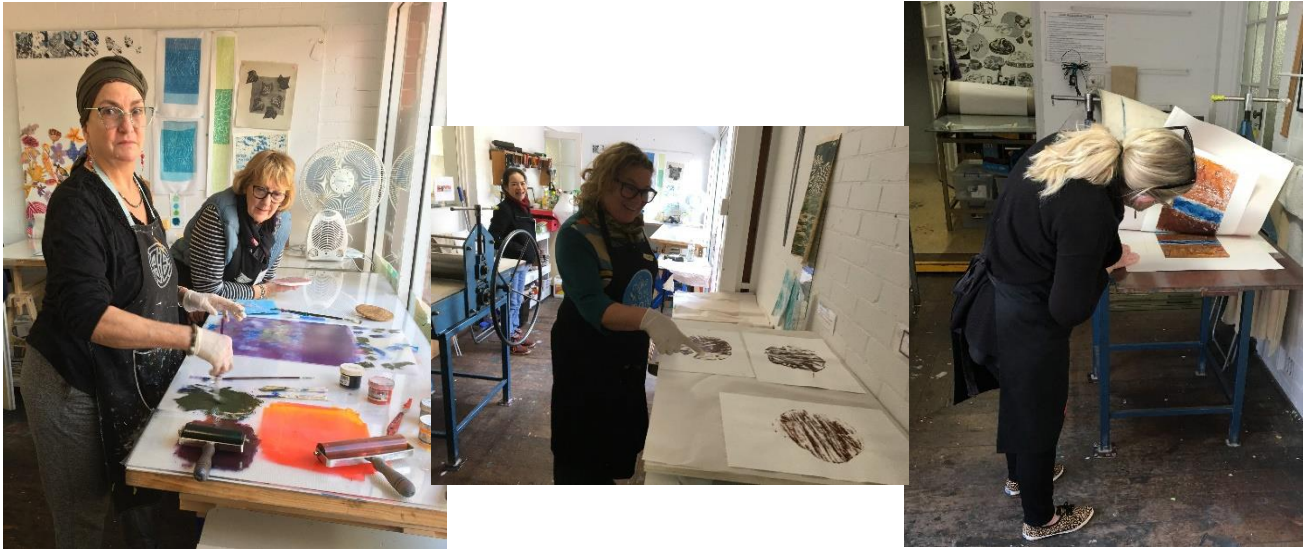
