

Did you know that all members have access to the PAWA studio at the Tresillian Art Centre in Nedlands? Enjoy exclusive use of the studio or get a small group together. If it's your first time at the studio, you need to have a 10 minute induction on site. Studio Mentors are available: an experienced printmaker from the PAWA committee can assist you with your printmaking in the PAWA studio.

\$25 a day or \$15 half day

\$35 a day or \$25 half day with a mentor

\$100 for block booking of 10 half days. Prepaid and to be used within 6 months of purchase.

We are offering members the opportunity to make group bookings of the studio at a reduced rate.

\$10 per person half day

\$20 per person full day

Francesco Geronazzo

18th of December 2022 - Dry point and Carborundum - 2 hours \$49

Generating tonal effects without the use of any chemical it's the aim of this 2 hour class. Being able to combine the drawing side of the process (dry point) with darker areas and details (carborundum) would be the focus of the workshop. This would make possible expand sizes of the plates while keeping the environment safe and sound.


15th of January 2023 - Monoprinting - 2 hours \$45

In this course (90 minutes) we will work with the natural environment around us. Working solely with natural forms: seeds/stems/leaves etc.. Anything else that you have sourced from nature can be included if you like. We will provide a variety of articles for you to choose from as well. We will produce a kaleidoscopic variety of images referencing back to the origins of the natural world around us. We will weave through various compositions, coloured prints and natural pigments derived from resins and spices.

22nd of January 2023 - Line etching 2 hours - \$49

Learn foundation skills applied in printmaking through a range of techniques; work on zinc or aluminum and cardboard plates.
We will work with different methods like Etching and Drypoint to start with, the chromatic options are also limitless!
This 2 hour workshop introduces the intaglio range of techniques to explore and expand the boundaries of traditional and contemporary printmaking.


