

PAWA Workshops: Presenter Terms and Conditions

PARTICIPANTS:

Workshop participants must be PAWA members.

Non-members are welcome to apply for PAWA membership prior to registering for a workshop by following the *Join PAWA* link on the *pawa.org.au* homepage. They should allow at least one week for their application to be processed before being eligible to register online for a workshop.

Unless otherwise agreed with the presenter:

- Maximum 10 places available.
- Minimum 6 places must be booked for workshop to proceed.

LOCATION:

PAWA Studio at Tresillian Arts Centre, 21 Tyrell St, Nedlands.

TIME:

We can assist you in determining a suitable date for your workshop.

Workshops on a Saturday or Sunday run for up to 6 hours usually commencing at 10AM.

Certain workshops may be run over more than 1 day subject to availability of suitable days.

EQUIPMENT and MATERIALS:

Use of PAWA equipment is included. Please check with our PAWA studio coordinator Petra Sara at petrasara11@gmail.com if you have any queries.

Workshop presenters are requested to list and cost any materials they will provide for the conduct of their workshop.

A materials cover charge will be added to the workshop registration fee for participants.

WORKSHOP FEES:

Registration fee is \$72 plus materials (unless otherwise agreed with PAWA).

Payment for workshop registration (including the materials charge) is made to PAWA.

REMUNERATION AND REIMBURSEMENT:

PAWA pays the workshop presenter:

- \$48 an hour workshop presentation fee plus 1 hour of preparation time.
- a materials charge for each participant (Max \$20 per head).

Payment to the presenter will be made within 7 days after the workshop.
